- Agronomy (sustainable production)
- Breeding (variety development)
- Value Added Processes (processing and utilization)

### **PULSE DAYS 2008**

Pulse Days runs one day only this year – Tuesday, January 8, 2008 starting at 7:00AM with a complimentary breakfast. Pulse Days is a premiere producer conference on peas, lentils, chickpeas, faba beans and beans. It draws pulse industry leaders and innovators from all around the world. Poster participants will receive one complimentary Pulse Days registration for the **Prairieland Park** location only.

### **AWARDS**

**Student** posters will be judged based on poster presentation and relevance to the Saskatchewan pulse industry. This year, a \$500 award will be presented to the top poster in each of the three categories.

# CALL FOR POSTERS

## POSTER GUIDELINES

- Target audience is pulse growers. Posters should focus on application of results and relevance to Saskatchewan growers and pulse processors.
- Research findings must relate specifically to pulses.
- Posters cannot promote specific company/organization products or services (non-commercial only).
- Only one poster per person please – we have a limited number of spaces available.
- Maximum poster dimensions - 4'X4'.
- Any text, tables, or graphs in your poster must be readable from 6' away and no text should be smaller than 20 point. Titles should be readable from 12' away.
- We encourage you to use bold fonts, especially for titles.
- Abbreviations should be spelled out at least once in your poster and in the abstract (preferably the first time it is used).
- **Important:** posters and abstracts must be written using terminology and language that **producers** will understand. Please do not include extraneous technical data or terms that the average producer cannot relate to.
- **Students are asked to provide a 200-225 word abstract for inclusion in the Pulse Days 2008 Conference booklet. Please see guidelines below for preparing your abstract.**

## ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

- Abstracts should be prepared in Microsoft Word (.doc).
- Title should appear in BOLD title case at the top of the abstract.
- All abstracts should be prepared in Arial, 10-point font.
- Single spacing should be used.
- Maximum length is 225 words.
- Principal author to appear first.
- An asterisk should be placed before the name of the author who will be presenting the poster.
- Last name of author(s) to appear first, followed by initials of first names.
- Please omit degrees and titles (Dr., Prof. etc).
- Author affiliations should include name of department and/or institution, city and province. Please do not include address.
- Please follow the sample structure below:
